At a Fireside Chat in Bethesda earlier this year I was pleased to present the 2015 Ellie Abramson Education Award to Pete Stogis. You may be aware that the Mediterranean countries now require the skipper of a bareboat to have either a US Coast Guard Captain's License or an International

Proficiency Certificate, which can be obtained after completing ASA 104 or the equivalent US Sailing Association course. Many of the SOS skippers and First Mates, having learned to sail before ASA or USSA existed, did not have either qualification. Pete, who has been a strong supporter of the SOS Bareboat program for many years and is also an ASA instructor, stepped forward last year to offer ASA 104 review clinics. He conducted four clinics and thirty-two SOSers now hold the International Proficiency Certificate. He will offer the clinics again this year.

Pete has graciously contributed to the planning of cruises by providing suggestions of places to visit, logs of his previous trips, copies of cruising guides, information about tricky places, and other hints along the way. 

From Bay Bridge (East bound):

Travel 17.2 miles eastbound on Route 50 and turn right onto Carmichael Road. Travel 5.1 miles on Carmichael Road until you cross the Wye Island Bridge. From the Wye Island Bridge, travel south on Wye Island Road for approximately 4.2 miles. Take left at "DNR Conference Lodge" sign. Go ½ mile to arrive at Conference Lodge complex.

From Easton (West bound):

Travel westbound on Route 50 to the Maryland Route 213 traffic light. Continue west on Route 50 for three miles and look for sign (Wye Island NRMA). Turn left onto Carmichael Road. Travel 5.1 miles on Carmichael Road until you cross the Wye Island Bridge. From the Wye Island Bridge, travel south on Wye Island Road for approximately 4.2 miles Take left at "DNR Conference Lodge" sign. Go ½ mile to arrive at Conference Lodge complex.



A Wild and Wonderful Winter Adventure!! Sail the Leeward Islands - February 18, 2017

Are you ready for an adventure in a new cruising ground? We are!!! SOS is arranging a winter getaway to the fabulous islands of the Leeward Island group. The islands include St. Martin, St. Barts, Nevis, St. Kitts and Antiqua. Steady tradewinds, some open water sailing and lovely, charming towns await us. They are more remote than the BVI, with stronger winds and more open water sailing. The islands are charming; each island a separate country. We will be sailing out of the Moorings/Sunsail base in St. Martin, which has reasonable flights on several major airlines. Both the 10 day and 7 day trips will leave the charter base on February 18. We plan to make staying on board the night before available to crew, but there are also lovely places to stay on St. Martin if you wish to arrive early or stay later for some R&R. The average temperature in the Leeward Islands in February is between between 75 and 80 degrees.

The Bareboat committee has reserved 6 boats: 4 Moorings 45.3 monohulls (3 cabins), 1 Sunsail 51.4 monohull (4 cabins), and 1 Sunsail 444 Catamaran (4 cabins). All skippers and crew must be approved by the committee; crew must have Basic Skills in order to be accepted as crew.

The cost of the trip varies based on the type and size of the boat. Here are the costs:

- Initial deposit, due at signup: \$500 for 7 day, \$500 for 10 day
- 2nd payment, due **August 15**: \$500 for 7 day, \$800 for 10 day
- Final payment, due **November 1**: \$500 for 7 day, \$800 for 10 day (+\$100 for each for the catamaran).

The cost of the trip does NOT include transportation or provisioning. It does include an administrative fee and a damage waiver per boat.

If you are planning to go, we will need your registration

and initial payment by **June 1**. This trip will fill quickly, so don't delay. The registration application is available online at



What the heck is the Basic Skills Program and why should I care?

You've joined SOS, signed up for your first Weekend or Day Sail and now someone says you should work on your Basic Skills during that sail.

The Basic Skills Program, an introduction to sailing, is a three-level study course and practicum. In addition to safety, the program was developed to help new members acquire a few skills so they feel more comfortable on boats and so skippers can be confident that crew members know a few basics (such as the "pointy end" is called the bow!) Below is a sample of some terms you will become familiar with.



Basic Skills 1 is considered to be a safety element for sailing with SOS. Usually this is completed on a Day Sail, but you may sail on a weekend cruise if you are prepared to be checked out on Basic Skills 1, and a skipper consents to do the checkout. The skipper's consent must be obtained by the coordinator.

The Basic Skills Manual and Checkout Sheets are located on the SOS website in 'Forms and Such' under *Education*, and may be downloaded.
