• If you DO want to receive a printed newsletter, you MUST check the appropriate box and pay the \$40 fee.

LIFE MEMBER RENEWAL:

NEW: Annual Life Membership fee of \$40 plus \$40 if you choose to receive a hard copy of monthly newsletter for the whole year.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE A LIFE MEMBER IF: you are 70 or older as of December 31, 2020 and you joined BEFORE March 31, 2009 and you have been a regular and/or associate member for over 10 consecutive years as of December 31, 2018. If you had any lapses in membership in the past 10 years, you are NOT a Life Member.

FEES & MEMBER PROFILE:

• You pay the \$40 renewal fee. But you must email the Membership Chair if you were a dues-paying member this past year to get approval for Life Member status.

• You MUST update your Member Profile to prevent any lapse in membership.

• You MUST pay \$40 if you wish to receive a printed newsletter.

INACTIVE MEMBERS (NEW CATEGORY)

Annual Inactive Membership fee of \$15 plus \$40 if you choose to receive a hard copy of monthly newsletter for the whole year.

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE AN INACTIVE MEMBER IF: you live outside of the Chesapeake Bay area and/or have physical or other limitations, and therefore no longer sail or attend social functions and you have been a member for 10 years or more.

- For online renewal, payment is by credit card or check.

• For mail-in renewal, payment is by check only.

• If you DO want to receive a printed newsletter, you MUST check the appropriate box and pay the \$40 fee

Inactive members:

- Will not have voting privileges.
- Will not be able to hold elected office.

•Would not have other benefits of membership.

• Could attend social functions only as the guest of a member, or by paying a non-member fee.

NEW MEMBERS:

First year membership of \$70 which includes a \$10 one-time administrative charge. New members will have the option of receiving a free hard copy of the Whisker Pole during the first year of membership; upon renewal the following year they will be able to opt in to continue receiving it with the same \$40 payment as current members.

Unofficial Notes November 15, 2020 Board Meeting

Official November minutes will be posted on the SOS web site when approved in December by the Board of Directors.

Congrats to new Board members: Robin Meigel, Pat Woodie, Craig Coltharp, Heidi Harper, and Wendy Adams. Sandy Rosswork has agreed to continue as Commodore. Teresa Scofield has agreed to continue as Treasurer. Robin Meigel is the new Vice Commodore. Craig Coltharp is the new Secretary.

All former Committee Chairs are continuing except for Skippers Advisory where Lorraine Fassett and Emil Becker will act as Cochairs and Social which is vacant. The Board of Directors action to confirm the Committee Chairs by email is confirmed at this meeting.

The Vice Commodore Burgee was presented to Robin Meigel.

Treasurers Report: There is \$13,712 in club checking account and \$73,449 in high yield savings. Net revenues steady, expenses minimal. There will be refunds for the cancelled Brunch of 15 November 2020.

Bareboat is considering possibility of promoting a "drive to" bareboat charter. Bareboat planning for 2022 will start soon.

<u>Cruising</u> stated that next year's cruising schedule will look very similar to the 2020 planned schedule.

<u>Database</u> reports that 74 members had renewed so far.

Education discussed the Zoom sessions held every Friday afternoon. People are encouraged to join the sessions, which are recorded. Spring training is proposed for May 1 at Camp Wabanna which may or may not include the Flare Demo.

Membership. New member packets have been sent out. The committee is looking into a policy for recognizing deaths of current and former members of SOS. To date 74 members have renewed for 2021. As a comparison at the same point of the renewal period last year 120 members chose to renew their membership. Life members who have chosen to dues to renew their pay membership is 34. Three members have chosen to renew as Inactive. This leaves a balance of 37 regular members as having renewed.

<u>Public Relations</u> reports that they have assumed ownership of the Club's Meetup platform.

Skippers Advisory reports a Skipper meeting is planned for the summer. They are looking into a session for skippers on raft building, and to hold a nautical flea market online.

<u>Social Committee</u> chair is VACANT! Volunteers needed.

The proposed Bylaw changes have been sent to the membership for approval. Final documents need to be sent to all. **New Business:** The new member motion was passed. The 30-day dues refund motion **for new members**, was passed.

The motion passed giving an entire year of membership to new members who join from October 1.

In Memory of Pete Stogis



Peter Douglas Stogis passed away on October 22, 2020 at the age of 84. He is survived by his loving and grieving wife of 17 years, Joan Stogis, and by many friends from his long active life.

After graduation from Purdue University Peter began his US Navy career as a pilot. He retired in 1983 with the rank of Commander, and turned his energy and talents to a passion for sailing.

A longtime member of SOS, Peter contributed his knowledge and experience to support the start of bare boat charters. In recent years, as European countries began requiring bareboat charter skippers to be licensed, Peter, who was an American Sailing Association instructor, offered the courses which qualified several SOS sailors as charter skippers.

Friends will gather to share memories and celebrate Peter's life when permitted by COVID -19 conditions.



In Memory of Dave Henkin (1944-2020)

Dave, a long-time skipper member of SOS, boat partner on *Triton*, and friend to many, died the November 16th, succumbing to the ravages of COVID. After moving to this area from Atlanta, Dave became very active guiding and promoting the sailing program of the Ski Club of Washington, DC. He came to SOS in 2003, and bought a boat docked where low tide often left him aground, hence his friendly moniker, "Hard Aground Henkin." Later he partnered aboard *Triton*.

He considered SOS family and over the last few years gave back by welcoming and mentoring new skippers into the club, for which he was given the Ellie Abramson Award in 2019. May you rest in peace, and know that many people will remember you. Please start preparing a place for us sailors-at-heart to come join you, so we don't end up as seagulls.
